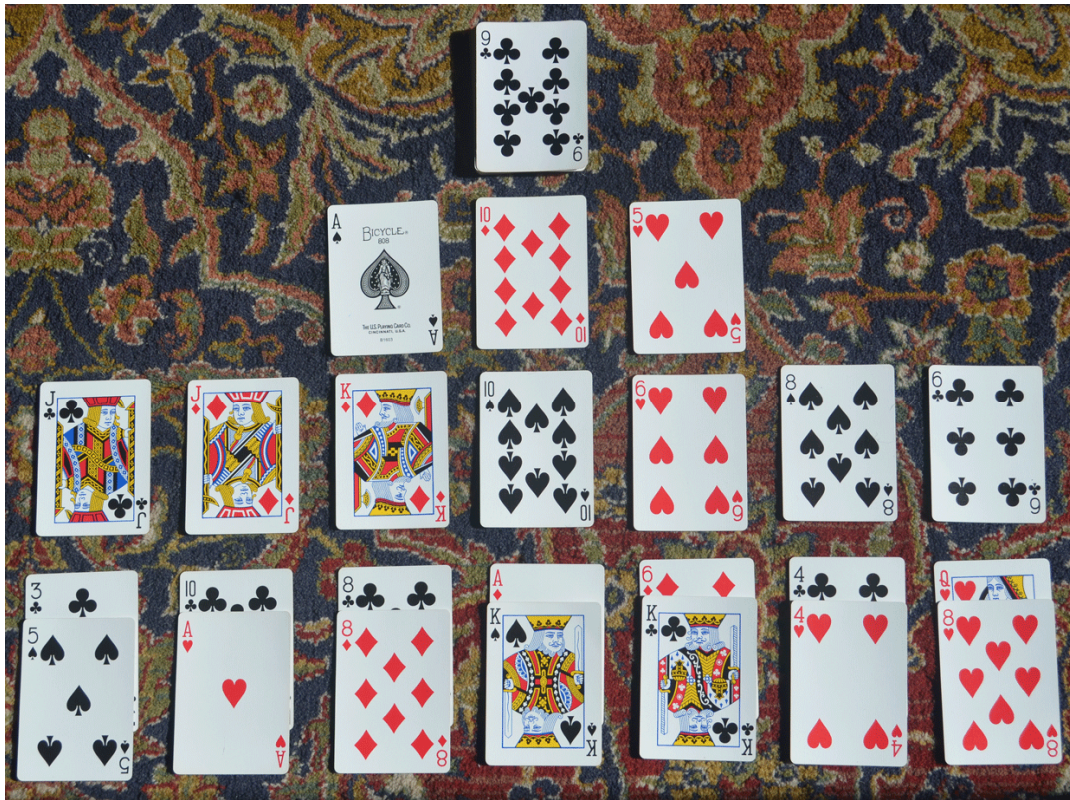

Welcome to the Weekly Reading Workbook. After years of publishing the original version, we lost the document it was created for. This book, like the Cards of Your Destiny book, teaches you to do this reading on Sundays and the reading begins the next day on Monday. What we have found is that the reading is more meaningful if you begin the reading on the day you were born. If you do not know what day of the week you were born, just go to this page on the internet:

Then, the day of the week you were born becomes your Mercury day of each week. I was born on a Friday and Friday is my Mercury day. You do your reading the day before your Mercury day. I do my readings on Thursday, for example. And by doing so, my planetary days in my readings are aligned with my natural planetary days. This will give you a more accurate reading.

I also decided to include here, some articles about the Weekly Reading and days of the week that would be helpful to students. I hope you enjoy them.

Our Personal Daily and Weekly Cards -

An Advanced Article

Over the past three or four years, many people have discussed the possibility of Daily Cards that are not randomly drawn as in the Weekly Reading. Several theories have come forth and I have experimented with these to see if they proved to be accurate. I also just examined the theory itself to see if it seemed sound or had a basis in the Science of the Cards as it was taught by Olney Richmond. Of the ideas presented to me by others, none have really proved themselves to be accurate or meaningful to me personally. However, they did give me the desire to find such a personal day card for myself and some ideas on just how it could be done so I am grateful to those who have shared their ideas with me and the many discussions we had on the topic.

Recently it came to me that, because of our Birth Card, we are somewhat limited as to the kinds of personal experiences we will have over the course of our life. Not that our Birth Card is in itself a limitation, but that when we make any choice, it naturally precludes other choices. We live in one body and thus cannot be in two places at the same time (though we would often want to). If we examine the Yearly Spreads and the 7-Year Spreads, from which our Long Range Cards come from, we will see that these Spreads are the essence of our life pattern. A person who is a Jack of Spades, for example, will only have his or her Yearly Spreads, and not the Yearly Spreads of anyone else. Though the Jack of Spades may actually have every single card in the deck in his or her Yearly Spread at one time or another, no other card will have the very same cards in any given year. It is a pattern that is defined by the Grand Solar Spreads, which is from where the Yearly Spreads and 7-Year Spreads are derived.

Our 7-Year Spreads and Yearly Spreads are the same on one level. For example, the Spread that governs the first year of our life and the Spread that governs the first seven years of our life are identical in every way. Every card is the same. If you look at your Long Range Card for Age 2, which is the 3rd year of your life, you will see that it is the same as the Mars Card in your Life Spread (Age 90). This is because the Mars Card is the 3rd Card and because our Age 90 Spread is also the Spread for the very first year of our life. Taking all of this into account, I figured that our Personal Daily Cards must also come from the same Spreads, since they would most likely be arranged in groups of seven just like the Yearly and 7-Year Spreads. When this came to me, it all fell into place and I believe I have arrived at one accurate method for determining Personal Daily Cards. That discovery lead me to realizing that there must also be Personal Weekly Cards because they fit together just like the Yearly and 7-Year Spreads. If you can follow it, the rest of this article will explain how you can calculate these for yourself. I have also incorporated this into my latest software program, The Book of Destiny Professional for

Windows. So, if this is too much math for you, your computer can do it all, without error, in a split second. I will describe that program more later.

To get the concept first, look at your Age 90 or Life Spread. This is where we begin because these are the cards that extend directly from your Birth Card, which is the card that governed the day you were born. Each of those cards, from the Mercury Card through the Neptune Card, govern a period of 13 years (or approximately 1/7th) of your life. The Venus Card, for example governed your life from approximately Age 12 through Age 25. Likewise, each of these planetary cards governed one year of your life. The Mercury Card was the Long Range Card for your first year and the Venus Card the second and so on. You will notice that the Venus Card in your Life Spread is also your Long Range Card for your Age 1 Spread. Age 1 implies the second year of your life. Now, imagine that these seven cards in your Life Spread also governed days and weeks. In other words, your Mercury Card also governed the first day of your life and the first week of your life. So there are the Personal Daily Cards for your first week and the Personal Weekly Cards for your first seven weeks, right there in your Life Spread. The question is 'where do I go after that first spread? And the answer is, to the next year's spread. After the first seven days, you progress to the next spread, which in this case is the Age 1 Spread. Therefore, the Age 1 Spread governed the second week of your life, each card governing one day and the Age 2 Spread would be the third week of your life and so on. Likewise, the Age 1 Spread governed the second, 7-Week cycle of your life where each of the planetary cards governed one week of that 7-Week cycle. Though this may sound complicated, if you give it a little time, read this again slowly, take out your book and count, you will have an invaluable tool for doing daily and weekly projections.

The trick to using this method is to be accurate in your counting. You really need to know how many days and weeks have elapsed since your birth in order to do these Daily and Weekly layouts. For example, when you were 90 weeks old, or around 22 1/2 months, you would have had to recycle back to the Life Spread (Age 90) to determine what cards you had for that week. This is just what happens if we live to be older than 90, we start back at the beginning again. So, the first step in doing these Daily and Weekly Cards is to know how many days and weeks have elapsed since the day of our birth. The only easy way I know to do this personally is to have the computer do it. There probably is an easy way and if you know one, I would be happy to share it with our readers. Since a 40 year old person has lived something like 14,600 days, and we need to be exact, it can be a little challenging, considering Leap Year.

Once we know how many days we have lived, we can divide it by seven and get how many weeks we have lived and how far we are in that week. Each new week in this method always begins on the same day of the week that we were born. Since I was born on a Friday, my weeks always begin on Friday. Friday becomes my personal Mercury Day each week. This

makes my Saturn day Tuesday and I can tell you that there are many experiences in my life that confirm Tuesdays as being Saturn to me.

I realize that this may be more trouble than it is worth to you, but I assure you, it is certainly a subject worth exploring. It will increase your knowledge of this system greatly if you take the time to figure these Daily and Weekly Cards for yourself. Our new computer program provides these for you at the click of a mouse button. It also gives you Long Range, Pluto, Result, Environment and Displacement Cards for each week and each 7-Week period of your life. That's a lot of cards to keep track of but it is also a lot of fun.

Our Personal Planetary Days

Our destiny software programs compute daily cards that are quite amazing and accurate. I have been studying them for quite some time and have discovered a few things that could be useful to those involved in the metaphysical sciences. To begin with, the day of the week in which we were born is very significant. There are systems of thought about that and some people offer some information about us based upon which day of the week we were born. What I want to talk about here is different. The day of the week that we were born determines which days of the week are governed by our personal planets. For example, if I am born on Wednesday, that becomes my personal Mercury Day. Thursday becomes my personal Venus Day, Friday my Mars Day and so forth. I have found that these personal days are very significant and later in this article I will give an interpretation of each of those personal days

The day of the week that you were born is always your personal Mercury Day. The next will be Venus, then Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune. Your personal Jupiter Day may not fall on Thursday but it will be the day you have a Jupiter influence. I have been watching this for a while and I am seeing some patterns here that I would like to share with you.

Personal Mercury Day:

This is usually a day of a lot of communications, phone calls, letters and often some short trips in the car or otherwise. Naturally communications are highlighted, and often with siblings or other family members. Things do tend to happen quickly on these days and not have a very lasting effect. This is the day to catch up on your phone calls, email and letter writing. Also the day to communicate your ideas and other things of importance to those around you. Friday is my Mercury Day and I do make a lot of phone calls that day. However, since a lot of people get off early on Friday, I have learned to make these calls early. I have also noticed that because it is Friday, people are usually not as friendly. I think many of them just want to go home and relax and can't wait to get off of

Personal Venus Day:

This is a day for beautification and indulging in luxuries or sensual pleasures. You may get your hair done or cut, purchase something special that you have wanted, eat some special food or otherwise indulge yourself in some way. There may or may not be relationship issues to deal with but home and family are often the focal point as are things to do with the arts or beauty. A good day to go out and buy that CD that you have been wanting to hear.

Personal Mars Day:

As you can imagine this is your passion day and maybe your day of irritability and impatience with situations and people around you. Dealings with legal matters or men may come to the forefront. You could have a lot of energy to get things done. Mars energy can help us initiate new projects or activities. It can also be the day that we feel the most sexual, though Venus can also do this. Try to avoid arguments on this day, you are more likely to blame others for your own problems now than usual.

Personal Jupiter Day:

This is your money day, and in general will probably be the day of the week when you experience the most prosperity. You will usually feel more expansive and have good ideas on how to increase whatever it is you are doing. Be careful not to overdo things on this day. But in general, this is probably one of the days you enjoy the most. My Jupiter Day falls on Monday, and because most of our income arrives in the mail, we always get a large pile of mail on Mondays laden with orders. This is definitely Jupiter for me.

Personal Saturn Day:

As you may well imagine, often the hardest day of the week in some ways. Katherine usually feels lonely that day, for no apparent reason. I noticed that in my pool league that meets on my personal Saturn Day each week, it is always a struggle and often I am really disappointed in what happens. It always seems to be an effort. Other days, I shoot like a pro but on Tuesdays, I have a very hard time. I think all of us have different issues that we address on our Saturn Day, but we usually do address them. Good day to keep a low profile. Try not to plan any important events on Saturn days, unless its a trip to a doctor or dentist. It is funny how many of my dental appointments end up on my Saturn Day. Saturn rules the bones and teeth and other health matters.

Personal Uranus Day:

This is a day when you could have an experience of inner freedom and the joy that brings. It's sort of like being released from prison after Saturn. It is often an expansive day and one that could bring some spiritual revelations. However, just when you least expect it, something can happen that threatens your security or upsets your plans. Unexpected events often occur on Uranus Days, as if Uranus was trying to show us places where we were attached and didn't know it. But, does Uranus have to be so sudden about it? I guess that is just his or her role in our life - to unexpectedly pull the carpet out from under us.

Personal Neptune Day:

Neptune is fantasy and escape day. Don't trust what you think you see on this day, because it is probably heavily laden with your own unfulfilled desires and dreams. You may find, as I do that this is a day that I often choose to go to a movie. Past-life events, dealing with drugs, alcohol and music, being by the ocean, meditation or seances. These all fall under the category of Neptune stuff so you may have some or all of these on your personal Neptune Day. Things that happen may help you feel connected to the universe on a broad scale, or may just be a fantasy that you pursue with no tangible results. Watch this day carefully and see what happens. You can learn a lot about your own hidden dreams and desires.

I think that you will learn a lot about the cards and astrology if you just pay attention to what happens to you on your personal days of the week. It is a fascinating study. Next, you can begin examining the personal cards that you have each week (I published an article about how to calculate these in the October, 1995 issue) and see how the planetary energies affect their interpretations. I have always maintained that the best and fastest way to learn about the cards is to compare one's personal experiences with the cards in your spreads. Here is another tool to accelerate this process.

The Days of the Week Are My Friends.

On my Mercury Day, I am ready to communicate. I plan short trips in my car and catch up on any necessary communications. I am agile and versatile. I don't take anything too seriously. This is not a day to be feared or revered in any particular way. But things are happening quickly and I remain alert and poised.

On my Venus Day, I think of shopping, especially for beautiful things to adorn myself and my home. I may also buy presents for those I love. I am enjoying my home and those close to me, especially those who live with me. I am a pleasure-seeker this day and anything goes!

On my Mars Day, I am competitive and energetic. I like to go hiking or workout in some way. Even though my Mars Day falls on a Sunday, I will often work because my passion wants to express itself in my work. I am careful with my interactions with others knowing I may come off a little too much! I channel my energies into positive expressions.

On my Jupiter Day, I am open to prosperity and any opportunities that present themselves. I also like to make business agreements and contracts on this day of the week. I plan promotional and money-making activities then and generally open up to ways that prosperity can flow to me in a bigger way. I open myself up more to receive the good things in life that may come on any level.

On my Saturn Day, I am prepared to work. If I just have this attitude of willingness to work for things, it all goes great for me. I schedule my dental and doctor appointments on my Saturn

Days. They seem to work best then. I do not expect bad things to happen but I prepare myself to do whatever is required when situations present themselves. In this way, Saturn is my friend.

On my Uranus Day, I am prepared for the unexpected. If things do not work themselves out the way I planned them, I do not take it personally. I know that the universe loves me and any unexpected events are to help dissolve any fixed notions or plans I have made unconsciously. I get to practice having no expectations on my Uranus day. What fun!

On my Neptune Day, I get to dream. I enjoy going to see a matinee that day or make some music. My imagination flies high and I direct it towards the positive. On these days, I dream of what could be, but without attachment. If my Neptune ideas are worth considering, they will still look good tomorrow (on my new Mercury Day!).

How to Get the Most out of Your Weekly Readings

The weekly readings taught in my workshops and in the Card of Your Destiny fulfill a vital purpose, both for beginners and for the advanced student of the cards. For beginners, they are able to get cards every day and every week that can be compared with the experiences and relationships in their lives so that they *learn the meanings of the cards by experience*. This is vital as the true meanings of the cards only reveal themselves to those who are sincerely interested in using this system for themselves. Once we have experienced what happens in our lives and have compared that to the cards we see in our weekly reading, we learn in a way that sinks in and becomes a part of our understanding. Later, when we share this understanding with others, whether we are giving them a reading or simply telling them about this system, we speak with power and conviction.

Once the language of the cards becomes part of our vocabulary, the weekly readings serve as a useful guide that reflect back to us what we are doing, saying and thinking. It becomes almost like a friend that reflects different parts of ourselves, often challenging us to rise up to higher standards of behavior and relating. This week, for example, I have a 3♣ as my Long Range card. Sometimes I look at this card and tell myself, 'Oh great, another week of worry and indecision.'. But this week I consciously chose to look at it and tell myself, 'Oh great, now I will have all the creativity I need to get some writing done!'. Well, here I am writing, and it is flowing very well. I have programmed myself in the past 6 months to think "creativity" whenever the 3♣ appears. In a way, I have created a positive association with that card that always inspires me to write. This is what each of us can do with the weekly readings. But there is more. I want to share with you exactly how I do a weekly reading, how I look at it and what I

think about it so that I get the most results possible for my life and use it as a tool to bring me more happiness and fulfillment.

First of all, I always light a candle and say a prayer just before I cut the cards for my weekly reading. I pray to my spirit guides and masters to teach me and ask them to use these cards to give me messages that will lead me to the light. Then I drop any desire for the cards to turn out in any certain way and promise that I will be open to what the cards are for the week and that I will learn from them. This, in itself, increases the chances that I will get positive results from these cards. Keep in mind that I want to use this reading to lift myself up to a higher level. It has become a ritual for me that keeps me connected to my spiritual path.

After I have laid the cards out, I first look for all the signs of success, power, and good fortune. First I look for the obvious. I look at the Jupiter card in the first row as representing what or whom will be a major source of blessings for me this week. Remember that every card manifests positively under Jupiter's influence. Next, I look for power, satisfaction and accomplishment cards. These are the Fours, Eights, Tens and the Face Cards in either the first row or the top row (Long Range, Pluto, Result and Environment). All of these cards represent success and satisfaction in one or more areas. Just having one of these cards in my reading is enough to give me a happy expectation of the week ahead and to feel safe and prosperous. Last week I had some pretty tough cards. As I laid them out, there were none of the "good" cards anywhere in the top row or the Long Range, Pluto or Result. Then I turned the deck over to see the Environment card for the week and it was an 8♠. I sighed a relief and knew that nothing negative could possibly happen to me that week.

The next thing I do is look at the top row of cards (numbers 1-7) and see what the week has in store. I look at them like this:

Mercury Card - tells me what I will be thinking about this week.

Venus Card - tells me who I will be having affection for or what I will love this week.

Mars Card - tells me what will inspire me to action or what will anger me this week.

Jupiter Card - tells me where my biggest source of blessings are for the week.

Saturn Card - tells me what this weeks biggest lessons will be about.

Uranus Card - tells me what will surprise me this week or what spiritual things will be occurring.

Neptune Card - tells me what I will be dreaming about this week. Who or what is in my dreams, hopes, secret desires, etc.

Of course, there are other meanings for the cards but these are the general ones that I attach to the first seven cards.

The last thing I do is look for cards that I don't understand at all. I watch carefully as the week progresses for signs that would indicate the true meaning of the cards. There is usually a secret message hidden for me in these cards. I keep an open mind and let the events of the week be my teacher. I am still learning new things about the cards every week and I hope you are too.

Introduction

Welcome to our very first video / workbook program. With this tool, you will gain a clearer understanding of the intricacies of the card science. You will be able to use this to do your own weekly reading with and to learn the subtle nuances of interpretation of the weekly reading.

It has been years since I first created and began using the weekly readings for myself and they have been one of the most important tools for my education in the Science of the Cards. Even now, I learn something new each week as I watch the events in my life and compare them to my cards for the week. The weekly reading has put me on a spiritual path of sorts. Each week's challenges opens up new doors of understanding. I can honestly say that I have learned more about the cards through this method than any other. I can also tell you that if you use this technique with sincerity, you will get the same results. Remember that we get out of anything exactly what we put into it.

The Decision Reading is also something I have used personally over the past four years with success. It isn't often that I am in a situation where I need this kind of help, but in those times that I did, the cards always helped me to understand myself better and inevitably led me to making a clearer and more self-empowering decision. This technique is fully elaborated on the video. I help eight different people with their weekly and decision readings and I am sure that you will be able to learn a lot from watching how I do those.

Keep in mind the importance of doing the timed shuffle and cuts. Often in our impatience we want to cut corners as we try to get to the answers we seek faster. However, if you do not perform the shuffle and cuts as specified, you will invalidate your readings and defeat your own purposes. Remember that Olney Richmond used and taught this shuffle and cut and that it was an integral part of every demonstration of the cards that he performed. By aligning ourselves with the magnetic energies of the planet, we insure consistent and accurate results.

I want to thank all of you who have given me so much feedback over the years and who have contributed to this card science by willingly sharing your questions and discoveries. Together we will eventually uncover all of the secrets of the Magi and ourselves become the 'magicians' of old.

The Weekly Reading

The Weekly Reading is your personal tool. It gives you important information about your life on a weekly basis that can help you make decisions and make better sense of the things going on in your life. But what is actually more important is that the Weekly Reading is the technique that will teach you the meanings of the cards faster than most anything else you could do. Because you will have direct experiences each week that you can compare with the cards that you draw, you will increase your learning rate many times. I have found that people learn things much more quickly by experience than by memorization. As you watch what happens each week and read the meanings of the cards in your reading, you will begin to understand the 'essence of the cards' by your personal experience. You will know when you have truly learned something about the cards because you will have a definite feeling that goes with that knowing.

To insure that your weekly readings are accurate, you must follow the instructions carefully. The timing of the shuffle and the cuts are of particular importance. This is a technique that has been passed down from Olney Richmond himself. The one-minute shuffle and three, twenty-second cuts were always performed at the beginning of any important reading or demonstration of the power of the cards. These shuffles and cuts are necessary to instill your *personal magnetism* into an otherwise randomly ordered deck of cards. Done correctly in the manner prescribed you will rest assured that all of your readings will be accurate and pertinent.

How to Do the Weekly Reading

There are specific instructions and rules for this reading that you must follow if you are to get the most out of it. Read them carefully so that you understand. First, the rules that you must follow:

RULES FOR THE WEEKLY READING

1. The reading is done every Sunday and covers one week beginning the following day, Monday.
2. You only do the reading once. If you do not like the cards you drew, take a closer look at how you are interpreting them. Every card has a positive side.
3. Always use the Bridge size playing cards (2 1/4 inches by 3 1/2 inches) and never use any decks that have different faces on the Jacks, Queens and Kings other than the standard faces. This rule is very important according to the Order of the Magi who were the original keepers of this science. Never use the Jumbo Index cards, Poker size decks, or any larger size deck as all of these constitute changes from the original deck of cards that is recommended.
4. Remove the Jokers from the deck before doing this reading. This is important according to the Order of the Magi as the Jokers will spoil and invalidate the reading if they are left in the deck. I usually just throw them away.

5. One final thought is that we never perform the weekly reading on December 31st, which is the Joker's day. On that day, which really has no card for its significator, no accurate readings may be obtained. Olney Richmond was able to perform hundreds of mystical 'tests' with the cards, but never on the day of the Joker.

PREPARATION

1. Find a quiet place in your home where you can be alone for 5 to 10 minutes and preferably where you can leave your cards laying out for the week if possible, such as a table top or dresser top. In this way you can observe them day by day as the week unfolds and learn much more about the cards as you go through the week.
2. Light a candle, put on some soft music and burn some incense. Do whatever you like to create an atmosphere of reverence for what you are about to do.
3. Make sure that you have a watch handy in order to time your reading. A watch with a second hand is essential.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE WEEKLY READING

The One-Minute Shuffle and Three, Twenty Second Cuts of the Deck

1. Watching your watch, wait until the second hand reaches the "12" and begin shuffling the deck. There is no right or wrong way to shuffle the deck, just be sure that you are handling and moving the cards around for exactly one minute.
2. When the second hand reaches the "12" again, cease shuffling and lay the cards down on the table in front of you. Watching your watch's second hand, wait 20 seconds, or until the second hand reaches the "4".

NOTE: you have a plus or minus 2 1/2 second margin for error on each of these timed actions, so don't fret if you miss the mark by a second or two. However, if you miss the mark by 3 seconds or more, stop, and then start the shuffle and cuts over from the beginning.

3. When the second hand reaches the "4", perform your first cut. A cut consists of removing some of the cards from the top of the deck with one hand, placing them to the side and then picking up the remaining cards and placing them on top of the cards you removed.

NOTE: You may use either hand for the cut, though traditionally the left hand was preferred because it is the feminine or receptive hand.

4. Wait another twenty seconds, until the second hand reaches the "8" and then perform your second cut of the deck.
5. Finally, when the second hand returns to the top of the minute, or to the "12" again, you may perform your third and final cut of the deck.

6. At this point, your deck of cards has your personal magnetism instilled in it and you need not have any concern about how soon you perform the reading. You can wait a few minutes or even hours as long as the deck is not disturbed. This is your deck now and every card in it is exactly where it should be as a reflection of your personal magnetism combined with the magnetism of the current day, hour and minute. These combinations of energies are what will guarantee an accurate reading for you.

Laying out the Cards

Before laying out my cards each week I like to close my eyes and say a small prayer. I don't pray for good cards or that I will win the lottery. Instead, I pray that I may understand my reading and gain some insight into myself and the Science of the Cards by its use. Then I open my eyes and lay out the cards.

1. Following the diagram, you lay out the cards, as numbered, face up. This means that your first card goes where the number 1 box is, the second on the number two box and so forth until all twenty four cards are on the table, face up. The last three cards that you lay down should be numbers 22, 23 and 24, which correspond to the Long Range, Pluto and Result for the week.

NOTE: I like to lap the third row of cards (numbers 15 - 21) on top of the second row (numbers 8 - 14). These cards being lapped over each other, while the top row is completely open helps denote the special significance of the top row (see the demonstration on the video). The bottom two rows are called the Underlying Cards, which we will discuss more later.

2. To get the Environment Card, simply turn the remaining cards in the deck over. The card that was on the very bottom of the deck is the Environment Card and should be placed at the very top of the layout as pictured.

Understanding the Structure of the Layout

All the cards except for the last four fall under one of the planetary headings. For example, the fourth card you laid down falls under Jupiter. So does cards number 11 and 18. These 21 cards are also associated with a certain time of the week, as they fall under the heading of Monday through Sunday. For this reason, we might call these the *Daily Cards*

The remaining four cards are all *Week-Long* influences and are governed by different forces than the Daily Cards.

Interpreting the Cards

1. Looking for Relationship Connections -

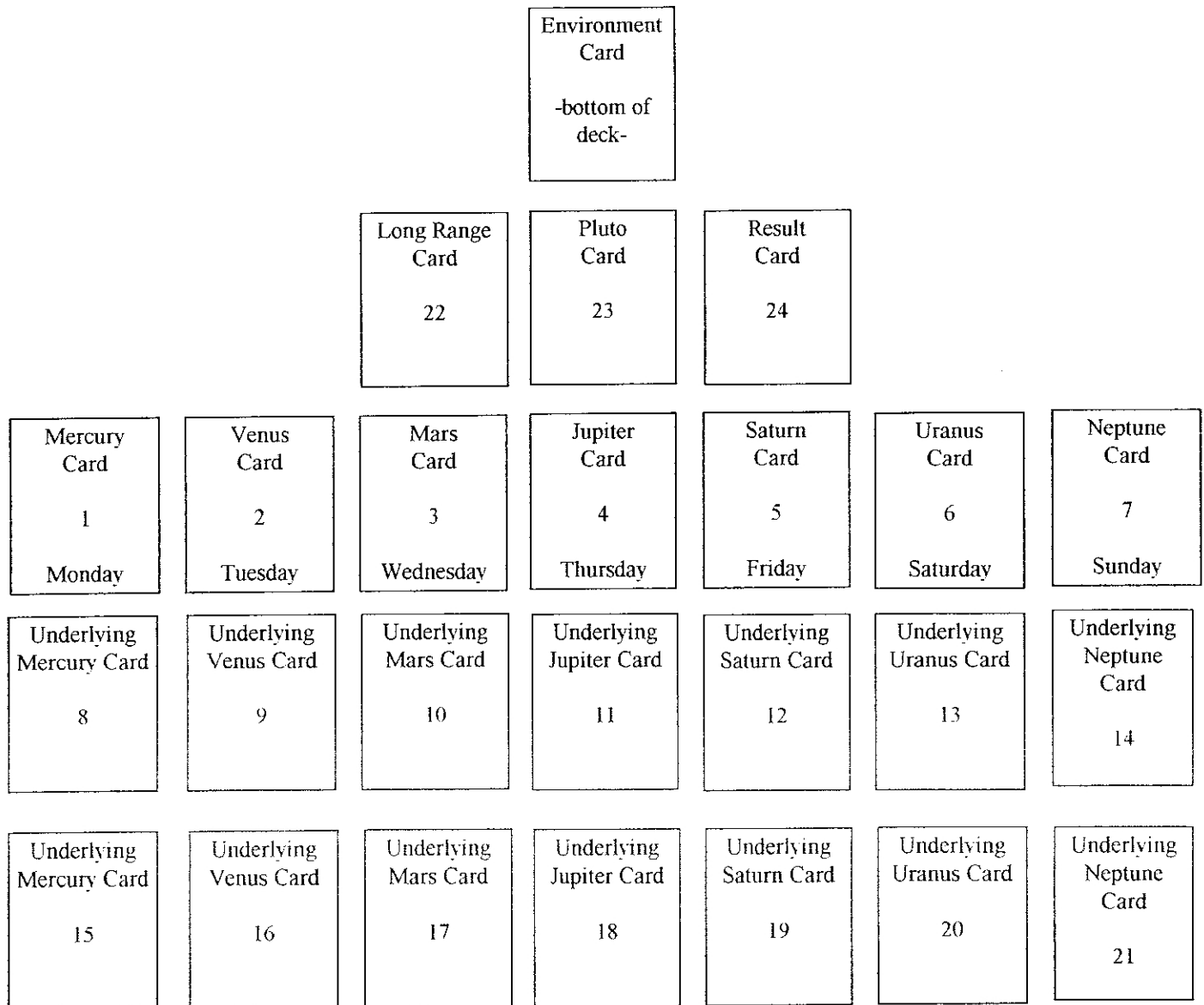
Before looking up any of the meanings of the cards, look for the Birth Cards, Personality Cards, and Karma Cards of people you know. All of these can be considered signifiers of the people in your life. Which ever position they fall under tells you what your relationship with them will be like this week. The meanings of these positions are found in detail in the Chapter Five of **The Cards of Your Destiny** but you can also use the 'Relationships Quick Reference Table' on the following page. For example, if someone's card that you know falls as card number 13, or under Uranus, you would read about the Uranus relationship to know how they would relate to you this week. Do this for every card of anyone you find in your reading. This tells you everything you need to know about your current relationships for the week.

2. Reading the Meanings of the Cards

This workbook provides you with abbreviated meanings for every card in every position but you can also use **The Cards of Your Destiny** if you want a more detailed explanation of the cards. You will have to translate the meanings, which are written to represent the occurrences on a yearly level, to a weekly level. In addition, **The Cards of Your Destiny** does not have interpretations for the Environment Card. However, for the Environment Card all you need to do is look up the Basic Meaning of the card and then read only the positive, high side interpretations of the card. More on the Environment Card later.

The Weekly Reading Layout



Instructions: After performing the shuffle and cuts as described on pages 2 and 3, lay out the cards in the order of the numbers on this page. Though it is not shown here, the third row (numbers 15 - 21) should be lapped on top of the second row so that only the top half of the second row (cards numbered 8 - 14) will show.

Do the Week-Long Cards First - It is usually best to look up the meanings of the week-long cards first, the Long Range, Pluto, Result and Environment Cards. These cards are the ones that will have the greatest impact on you this week and will describe the most important forces present. As you read their meanings, keep the following in mind.

The Long Range Card defines who or what is the most important focus of your attention this week. It is neither bad nor good, but merely important to you in some way.

The Pluto and Result Cards together will define what are your goals and challenges for the week. I find these two cards to be the most interesting and often the hardest to understand. I often do not really understand them until the week is almost over. They tell me where, in my life, I am making internal changes in response to the will of God. They define where I am being transformed and changing.

The Result Card alone also defines what or who you will end up with by the close of the week. The Result Card is always interpreted on the high side, being connected to Jupiter astrologically. It will be a blessing of some sort that you will end up with before the week is up.

The Environment Card is a helpful, protective, and surrounding influence for the week. It will be either a person or just a quality that will come to your aid throughout the week and bring some good energy into your life. The Environment Card is liken to a Jupiterian influence but has a sort of nurturing or protective quality about it.

The Daily or Planetary Cards for the Week

Now you can look up the meanings of the *first seven cards* that you laid down. These cards are the main cards for the week, just like the direct cards in your yearly spread. I suggest that beginners don't read the two rows of underlying cards until they have been doing the Weekly Reading for several months. It is best to simply use the underlying cards to find relationship information.

You get the interpretations for the first seven cards in the same fashion as the Long Range, Pluto, and Result Cards by looking up the meanings in the Interpretations chapter of **The Cards of Your Destiny** or by reading the mini interpretations in this workbook. The first card is the Mercury card, the second, Venus, and so on.

Now look at this same first row of cards as being the cards for each day of the week, beginning on Monday. The headings at the bottom of the page tell you which card falls on which day in case you forget. In this way, you have a card for each day of the week. The underlying cards may tell you who is involved in the events of that day. Watch carefully what happens as you go through the week.

NOTE: We have found that sometimes the cards do accurately reflect exactly what happens on a particular day and other times they are off by a day or two. It is safe to say that they will reflect what is going on at that general time of the week. In other words, the cards under Mercury, Venus and Mars will talk about things happening at the beginning of the week while the Saturn, Uranus and Neptune cards will reflect more of the things happening at the end of the week.

Other Considerations and Ideas

I suggest that you make copies of the layout diagrams at the end of this book and make a record of each week's reading. I have left enough room in the boxes for you to write in the cards that you pulled for that week. Then, you can make notes on the page as to what happened as you went through the week. This exercise will teach you more about the cards in a short period of time than anything else you could do.

I also suggest that you do these weekly readings for your friends and family. I have never met anyone that would refuse a free reading. This provides you with more experience and more fun too.

NOTE: I caution you not to take the cards in your weekly reading too seriously. Many beginners make the mistake of interpreting these cards just as they would a yearly spread. The fact is that these cards are minor influences and very transitory. As you do these readings for yourself and others and see how things turn out, you will realize that you really cannot interpret them just the same as you would the same cards found in a yearly spread. They just don't have the same strength. Again, the best policy is to lay the cards out, look them up, and then wait and see what happens. You will learn much more by comparing the cards with your own experiences than you will by trying to figure out what they mean ahead of time.

Advanced - Reading the Underlying Cards

If you feel ready, you can also learn to interpret the two cards, the underlying cards, that fall beneath the major seven in the first row. I caution you to not try an advanced reading until you are comfortable with the basic interpretation of the major cards. An advanced reading can be very confusing and difficult to learn; however, if you have pretty well mastered the weekly reading and feel comfortable that you understand most of the meanings of the cards, you should go to the next step, the advanced reading.

As underlying cards, the two cards under each of the first seven refer only to the card above them. For example, card numbers 9 and 16 only relate to card number 2. They are read by looking up their meanings in the same way as you look up the card on top. However, you see them as background influences for the card on top. They are often the people involved in the situation described by the top card or other factors about the situation. If the top card is the card of someone you know, the underlying cards may describe what they will be doing in your life that week or give you other information about how they will relate to you. Often you have to combine their meanings together with the top card's meaning to get the whole story. The top card is like the headline card, the most important influence. The underlying cards give you the details under that headline.

Our Pluto and Result Cards - an article that appeared in the March, 1994 issue of **Voice of the Seven Thunders** newsletter

Each year and week we have a Pluto and Result Card. These two cards are very significant in terms of what they reveal about what is going on in our lives on a deep, internal level. When I first learned about these two cards, Arne Lein, my teacher, told me they were called the Challenge and Result Cards. This word challenge was a good place to start but after I studied the cards for a while and did a couple of hundred readings I realized that the word 'challenge' was somewhat limiting in its definition and that most people had a negative reaction to it. Because this Challenge Card is the card that follows the Neptune card in the Grand Solar Spreads and because Pluto is the planet that follows Neptune in the heavens, I changed the name of the Challenge Card to the Pluto Card. My knowledge of astrology immediately kicked in and there before me was a much more comprehensive definition for the Challenge Card, one that covered many more possibilities and gave a much deeper meaning. It is also very possible that a different name will come up for the Result Card because it is the card that follows the Pluto Card in the Grand Solar Spreads. However, since there is no official planet following Pluto yet, I will wait until it becomes available.

Pluto is the god of Death and transformation. When we look at our Pluto and Result Cards, we are looking at elements in our lives that are in the process of great change. In many cases it is fair to say that we are making a transformation from our Pluto Card to our Result Card. Knowing this is very helpful when we are doing our yearly reading or our weekly reading. If you look at those two cards in that light, I am sure that you will come up with some deeper insight regarding their meaning in your life. Keep in mind that the Result is something or someone that we end up with by the end of the week or year, depending upon which reading we are talking about. Whatever or whoever you end up with is really what you have transformed into.

A client of mine is a 5♦ and one week he had a J♦ Pluto and K♥ Result Card. He was having some difficulties in his relationship, mostly centering around his desire to play around. This 'playing around' part of him is represented by his J♦ Pluto Card. Remember that a man's Jack represents his youthful, creative, romantic and immature sides. Jacks can be too much into play and they can be dishonest at times. My client's K♥ Result Card indicated that as the week progressed, he would make a major transformation from that Jack to the 'King of Love'. The K♥ is someone who is emotionally mature and fair with his affections. These two cards together told me that he was going through a process of shedding the skin of his Jack of Diamonds and becoming the responsible and mature K♥. Now we must remember that this is what is going on for him on the inside. These cards represent the personal struggle and changes that he is making that week. The actual result of the week and what would happen between him and his girlfriend are a little harder to determine. The K♥ could mean he becomes a single bachelor, because K♥ men often make better lovers than husbands. They have a lot of charm and enjoy the attention of women. On the other hand, with all the maturity that comes with that King, he may just as well decide to stay with his current relationship, but approach it with more maturity and responsibility. Whatever the external outcome, we can say with assurance that this man will undergo an internal transformation from being somewhat irresponsible to being more mature and responsible, both emotionally and in respect to his current relationship.

This same example illustrates another way to look at the Pluto and Result Cards in any given reading. That is, that they represent two options that one is faced with. Often the Pluto and Result Cards appear as two ways that we can go, each different. We are faced with a choice and these two cards are the options that are available to us. In our previous example,

we can see that this man had to choose between his Jack side and the King of Hearts way of expressing himself. What actually happens is that we always end up with the Result Card on some level, so that even though it appears as a choice at the outset and we may fret and fuss until we make that choice, we always end up making that transformation to the Result Card, either by the end of the week or the end of the year depending upon which reading we are doing.

In my own personal life, this understanding of these two cards has brought much more significance into the readings I do for myself. The Pluto and Result Cards represent things that others may not even be aware of that are extremely important in our lives. They are personal to us alone and they have a special message about the deepest issues that we are facing within the context of the current weekly or yearly cycle that we are in.

How to Get the Most out of Your Weekly Readings - an article that appeared in the January, 1993 issue of **Voice of the Seven Thunders** newsletter

The weekly readings taught in my workshops and in **The Card of Your Destiny** fulfill a vital purpose, both for beginners and for the advanced student of the cards. For beginners, they are able to get cards every day and every week that can be compared with the experiences and relationships in their lives so that they *learn the meanings of the cards by experience*. This is vital as the true meanings of the cards only reveal themselves to those who are sincerely interested in using this system for themselves. Once we have experienced what happens in our lives and have compared that to the cards we see in our weekly reading, we learn in a way that sinks in and becomes a part of our understanding. Later, when we share this understanding with others, whether we are giving them a reading or simply telling them about this system, we speak with power and conviction.

Once the language of the cards becomes part of our vocabulary, the weekly readings serve as a useful guide that reflect back to us what we are doing, saying and thinking. It becomes almost like a friend that reflects different parts of ourselves, often challenging us to rise up to higher standards of behavior and relating. This week, for example, I have a 3♣ as my Long Range card. Sometimes I look at this card and tell myself, 'Oh great, another week of worry and indecision.' But this week I consciously chose to look at it and tell myself, 'Oh great, now I will have all the creativity I need to get some writing done!'. Well, here I am writing, and it is flowing very well. I have programmed myself in the past 6 months to think "creativity" whenever the 3♣ appears. In a way, I have created a positive association with that card that always inspires me to write. This is what each of us can do with the weekly readings. But there is more. I want to share with you exactly how I do a weekly reading, how I look at it and what I think about it so that I get the most results possible for my life and use it as a tool to bring me more happiness and fulfillment.

First of all, I always light a candle and say a prayer just before lay out the cards for my weekly reading. I pray to my spirit guides and masters to teach me and ask them to use these cards to give me messages that will lead me to the light. Then I drop any desire for the cards to turn out in any certain way and promise that I will be open to what the cards are for the week and that I will learn from them. This, in itself, increases the chances that I will get positive results from these cards. Keep in mind that I want to use this reading to lift myself up to a higher level. It has become a ritual for me that keeps me connected to my spiritual path.

After I have laid the cards out, I first look for all the signs of success, power, and good fortune. First I look for the obvious. I look at the Jupiter card in the first row as representing what or whom will be a major source of blessings for me this week. Remember that every card manifests positively under Jupiter's influence. Next, I look for power, satisfaction and

accomplishment cards. These are the Fours, Eights, Tens and the Face Cards in either the first row or the top row (Long Range, Pluto, Result and Environment). All of these cards represent success and satisfaction in one or more areas. Just having one of these cards in my reading is enough to give me a happy expectation of the week ahead and to feel safe and prosperous. Last week I had some pretty tough cards. As I laid them out, there were none of the "good" cards anywhere in the top row or the Long Range, Pluto or Result. Then I turned the deck over to see the Environment card for the week and it was an 8♠. I sighed a relief and knew that nothing negative could possibly happen to me that week as the 8♠ is a powerful card of overcoming any and all problems. In the Environment position, it acts as a 'protective umbrella'. There was really nothing to worry about.

The next thing I do is look at the top row of cards (numbers 1-7) and see what the week has in store. I look at them like this:

Mercury Card - tells me what I will be thinking about this week.

Venus Card - tells me who I will be having affection for or what I will love this week.

Mars Card - tells me what will inspire me to action or what will anger me this week.

Jupiter Card - tells me where my biggest source of blessings are for the week.

Saturn Card - tells me what this week's biggest lessons will be about.

Uranus Card - tells me what will surprise me this week or what spiritual things will be occurring.

Neptune Card - tells me what I will be dreaming about this week. Who or what is in my dreams, hopes, secret desires or fears, etc.

Of course, there are other meanings for the cards but these are the general ones that I attach to the first seven cards.

The last thing I do is look for cards that I don't understand at all. I watch carefully as the week progresses for signs that would indicate the true meaning of the cards. There is usually a secret message hidden for me in these cards. I keep an open mind and let the events of the week be my teacher. I am still learning new things about the cards every week and I hope you are too.

The Decision Reading -

The Decision Reading is one that you can use whenever a situation comes up where you are presented with more than one option and must make a decision. The cards can tell you more about each of the options so that you can make a more informed decision about which to choose.

Many times in our lives we are faced with making a decision. And in many of these cases neither one of the options is necessarily bad. For example, suppose you are faced with deciding upon two different jobs. One may pay more while the other may bring you greater freedom or opportunities for self-expression. It's not that either one is better than the other, it is only that you have to decide which is most important to you. Often the decision is difficult because we haven't thought the whole thing through and seen what each of the options has to offer. The cards can illuminate not only the darkness about what each choice has to offer, but also can reveal some aspects about the *future possibilities* of each choice that *you are not now aware of*. For this reason, it is a good idea to throw a decision reading before making final choices of importance. Here's how it is done.

Do a Decision Reading

Preparation - Light a candle and prepare to do this reading in a quiet place where there is no interference or disturbing noises. You should be alone if possible.

Define the Options for the Reading -

Before shuffling the cards, it is important that you clearly define what the choices are that you desire information about. You have to specify each of the options carefully and each one should exclude the other options. You can have as many options as you want, but they should all be mutually exclusive of each other. For example, if you are choosing between going on a vacation and going to see your Aunt Mable, it should be clear that you cannot do both. Only use this reading for choices where choosing one of the options excludes choosing the other options. Also, the choices you are creating should be about the same issue in your life. In other words, each of the possible options should have something in common, usually that they will fulfill a certain purpose in your life. For example, you wouldn't use the decision reading to make a choice between eating chocolate ice cream and going to college in the fall. These two options have nothing in common.

So, to complete this first step, you must analyze the situation that you are thinking about and get your question down to a certain number of options. Most questions are resolved with two or three options but there are examples where you could need more. For example, suppose you had three different job offers come up, plus the option of continuing with your current job. You could pose four options, one for each possibility. The first option would be "What would happen if I stayed with my current job?". The second option would be "What will happen if I choose to take job option number one?" and so forth until you have clearly delineated each of the options.

It is important to speak these options out loud or to write them down before proceeding with the rest of the reading. This helps you clarify the options you are creating and will give you clearer results. To see how this is done, watch the examples we do on the video.

Using the Decision Reading for Yes or No Questions - The cards will not tell you what you should do but they can tell you what's in store for you if you go in a certain direction. Therefore, you can pose a yes or no question as options and the cards can help you make a decision. For example, suppose you wanted to know whether or not you should continue dating a certain person. You could pose the question as two options. The first option would be to continue dating the person and the second option would be to break up. It is as simple as that. Using that format, the cards will tell you more about what will happen if you were to choose one of those directions.

Preparing and Shuffling the Deck of Cards

Once you have your choices clearly defined you are ready to prepare the deck of cards. This is done by performing the one-minute shuffle and three, twenty-second cuts of the deck, just as illustrated in the previous section about the weekly reading. Remember to remove the Jokers from the deck and to time this precisely.

Laying out the Cards for each of the Choices

Announce each of the choices available to you and as you do so, lay down three cards, face down, for each choice. For example, you might say, "These cards are for job number one, these cards are for job number two..." and so forth until you have three cards, face down, for each of the possible choices available to you. Keep the sets of three cards that represent each choice separate from the cards of other choices. When you are done you will have three cards, face down, for each of your options.

Interpreting the Cards for each Choice

Turn over the three cards for your first choice. These three cards, both individually and combined, will tell you what you need to know about that choice. First read each of the cards' meanings separately. Look up the Basic Meaning of the Cards in the Interpretations chapter of **The Cards of Your Destiny**. See each card as a separate element that will come into play if you were to make that choice.

EXAMPLE

Let's say, for example, that I was deciding upon which job to take out of two possible jobs and the cards for job number one were the K♥, 7♦, and the 2♥. How would you interpret these cards? I would say that this job offered the possibility of being in a leadership position where I could share love with others (K♥). Financially, this job would probably be challenging (7♦). I would probably need to be doing it for the love of it rather than the money. Lastly, there is the possibility of meeting a new love partner or of making a new close friend on this job (2♥). Now, if money was not the most important thing in my life at this time and relationships were high on my list of priorities, I may select this job over another that promised greater financial security.

Now, do the same thing for the other possible choices you have by turning over the next three cards for the next choice and reading them in the same way.

Special Cases -

If you watch the video carefully as I help the eight people with their Decision Readings, you will note some special things that often happen with these readings. The first one I want to mention is where the last of the 3 cards is often seen as the Result of that particular decision. For example, your first two cards for a particular choice may be challenging such as sevens or nines but the last card would be an eight. This would indicate that though there would be some personal challenges, you would be able to overcome them in the end. Sevens and Nines are usually associated with problems and difficulties of one kind or another. However, they are very potent cards on the spiritual level and can hold immense rewards in terms of personal growth if that is what you are looking for. So, you can see that it is important to know what your point of view is as you look at these cards. But don't fool yourself either. It would be a mistake to think that a seven or nine is not going to present some kind of challenge for you.

Another scenario that comes up more than once in the video is where the cards tell you what is going to happen, even though you make a certain choice. To better explain this, let's take an example. Let's say that you are trying to decide whether to take a trip or to just stay home for the summer. But after you do the reading and uncover the cards for staying at home, you find that there are one or more fives under the option for staying home. Since fives are the cards for trips and changes, this could indicate that you will be taking the trip anyway. This happens sometimes and when it does, it comes as a special gift. Perhaps you had really already decided to take that trip and you just needed the cards to point it out to you.

I have noted that when we are undecided about something, it is usually because we haven't taken the time to explore the ramifications of the possibilities for ourselves. Sometimes just the process of phrasing the questions and options is all we need to suddenly become clear about what we really want to do. As you get more familiar with the cards and do readings for yourself, they begin to take on a more intimate role in being your guide and friend. However, I never intended this to be a system that we give our power away to and I will never give the cards the power to shape my destiny. This is a tool to explore ourselves and if we use it in the way it was intended, the net result will be for us to regain our personal power and to have a lot more fun and prosperity in our lives.

A passionate love affair or romantic involvement, aggressive pursuit of relationships of all kinds.

As the Venus Card

The Marriage Card, satisfaction in love and romance and family, I have enough love.

As the Mars Card

An aggressive or highly sexual marriage, satisfaction in love and friendships, especially with men, or much aggression between you and your partner.

As the Jupiter Card

A blessed marriage, financially and / or spiritually, financial or spiritual benefits coming from the marriage partner or your closest relationship, a marriage into money. Your partner is making money for you.

As the Pluto Card

I want new people and love experiences in my life. I am challenged to change my relationships and discard the past.

As the Result Card

I achieve new freedom in my choice of friends or lovers. I successfully broaden the scope of my friends and associates.

As the Mercury Card

Fickleness and restlessness that brings many changes emotionally and in relationships, sudden separation or unexpected travel away from or to loved ones.

As the Venus Card

The Divorce Card, a trip away from loved ones or a trip with loved ones.

As the Mars Card

Strong restless energy emotionally, divorce with anger or legal battle.

As the Jupiter Card

A financially beneficial divorce or separation or change in the business, a successful business

As the Saturn Card

A difficult divorce or separation, a trip because of illness of self or others.

As the Uranus Card
